




- Founded in 2014
- Local licenses in Cambodia and Switzerland
- Help for self-help for rural Cambodian schools, mainly primary schools
- Facilitation via three core programmes: **Sustainable Building & Renovation, Water & Sanitation and Education**
- Our local team of six ensures careful planning, effective realisation and thorough monitoring of projects, thereby respecting local culture and habits
- Background work, governance, fundraising performed by a Swiss Board of five
- Tax-free status recertified by Canton of Zurich in Sep 2018
- ZEWO high quality seal since December 2018
(successfully recertified in 2023)

Sustainable Development Goal 4 (SDG 4) is the education goal. It aims to “ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all”.

Sustainable Development Goal 3 (SDG 3) is the goal for access to Good Health and Well Being. It aims to “ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages”.

Sustainable Development Goal 6 (SDG 6) is the goal for access to clean water and sanitary equipment. It aims to “ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all”.



Even with few resources we can achieve a big impact

- Inequality of opportunity: of 100 children from Cambodian families with IDPoor status, 93 start school - but only 13 reach high school
- In the communities where Kamboo Project operates, this ratio is improving measurably and noticeably
- We pay particular attention to increasing girls' school enrollment rates

As a small NGO, we measure ourselves against the standards of large NGOs: ZEWO licensed since 2018

- Of the approximately 13,000 non-profit organizations in Switzerland, around 500 are ZEWO certified
- Of these approximately 500, Kamboo Project is the smallest!
- On an annual average, Kamboo Project has converted one franc spent on fundraising into 176 francs of project money since 2018 (return 176:1)
- The average of ZEWO-certified CH NGOs is 6:1!

- Pair of school uniforms: USD 15/student
- Bicycle and repair workshop USD 50/student
- Workshop “Girls Early Marriage Prevention”: USD 400 per group of female students in grade 5-6
- Equipping a library with books: USD 750
- Scholarship for a girl: USD 750-1'500
- Drinking water station: USD 1'000
- Starting a school vegetable garden: USD 1'000
- Flooring or roof of classroom: USD 1'500
- School kitchen / outdoor mensa: USD 3'000
- Fence repair against flooding: USD 3'000
- 2-yr hygiene training programme (“SHIP”) for entire school of 300 students: USD 5'000-8'000
- ICT Computer Lab with 12 work stations: USD 7'000
- New toilet house /water system: USD 10'000
- New school building: USD 45'000
- Fixing an “abandoned school” from start to finish over a 5-yr period: between USD 60'000-200'000
